Focusing on Reading at Congewai!

Having every student becoming an active and engaged reader is one of our primary goals at here at Congewai. Reading is a crucial skill that is required right across the curriculum and one that broadens the horizons of all of us.

Each day In class children engage with books in 3 ways. Students participate in Home Reading or Recreational Reading activities, reading books that they can read fluently to promote expression and confidence. In daily Guided Reading groups, students study a more challenging text over several lessons, developing fluency, expression and comprehension skills. Finally Modelled Reading takes place where the teacher reads a story to the class, providing students with an example of how expert readers read and access to a rich source of vocabulary and experience.

This can all be reinforced with reading at home, where children can read to parents or big brothers and sisters. And don't forget that children are never too old to hear their parents read a story - parents are expert readers and it is an opportunity to model the importance of reading to your kids.
