### School Planning


Last week, we completed External Validation for our school. This is a very important feature of our planning processes and whilst we, as a staff, are relieved to have it behind us, we found it to be a very valuable experience. We are now heading into a new four-year planning cycle. As such, over coming weeks, we will be asking students,



parents, and community for feedback on what is working and what could be improved. We value all constructive feedback and will use this to shape our School Improvement Plan. We really look forward to working with our school community to create positive pathways for the future.

## **Maths Bootcamp**

Students are enjoying the opportunity to combine physical fitness with numeracy each morning in Maths Bootcamp sessions. The students rotate around various mathbased activities and perform exercises which support engagement, motor skills, core strength and fitness. This has been a lovely way to start each day with the weather warming.



#### Number Talks

We are really excited about the progress students are showing with their number sense and their ability to share their thinking in a variety of ways. Students are provided with an open-ended number problem and are asked to think about how they could solve this and show their thinking. We have a heavy reliance on whiteboards – students are more willing to take a risk when it can be rubbed away quickly, and they can have another go. We are working hard to strengthen resilience and persistence.

#### Karaoke Lunch-breaks

Our new microphone and speaker have been getting a work-out during lunch-breaks with students enjoying karaoke style sing-alongs. This has been most entertaining!

#### Kokedama

On Friday we made kokedamas. These are a traditional way of growing plants in Japan, where the plant is wrapped in moss (or hessian). Don't forget to give them a regular soak in a bucket!



#### Imaginaturalist

Fridays are extra exciting this term with the introduction of Imaginaturalist. Students have enjoyed participating in a range of science-based art activities as they learn about animal adaptations with a particular focus on birds. They are gradually developing a portfolio of work samples which they are looking forward to sharing with you upon completion of the unit. After surveying, students, we have decided to continue our Imaginaturalist sessions into next term also.

#### Year 5 Check-in Assessments

As we will not be doing NAPLAN this year, we have opted into a Year 5/Year 3 check-in through the Department of

These snapshot assessments provide us with valuable information for planning so that we can best meet the needs of our students. We will ensure that this is not a stressful situation for students and there is no need for them to study.

Please ensure that students have hats and water bottles for school. We will be encouraging students who do not have hats to play under the shelter.


